
#### KIA'S VIOLATION OF THE LANGUAGE LAW.

#### 2. Opening ceremony




A very severe violation of the language law. The Slovakian language version must be identical. In order to comply with the language law the Slovakian language version should come first and the letter size should be equal to the English language version. On this picture it is very clear that the Slovakian language version does not come first and has a smaller letter type.

5. Usage of English words or not Slovak text in advertisements.



A very severe violation of the language law. It is forbidden to use English language text in advertisements if they are not preceded with a Slovakian language version text.

In the KIA car factory English language signs can be found that are not accompanied with a Slovakian language version. This is a very huge violation of the language law.


